EUROPEAN CLIMATE PACT

While many of our actions may seem small in isolation, taken together the impact is far bigger than in our individual world.

Who is the Pact for?

Everyone has a place in the Pact. You can get involved whether you are just starting out on your climate action journey or already working to make a difference in your world. You can also take part as an individual or as an organisation – for example, a city, a company or an association.

Whoever you are, the Pact aims to help you to:

- Learn about climate change and what it means for your world.
- Make practical changes – big or small – to reduce your impact on the environment.
- Get together with others to share ideas and experiences.
- Be a change-maker in your own world and inspire others to act.
- Take action with those around you – friends, colleagues or neighbours – to maximise your impact.



The European Climate Pact encourages everyone to act.

It is a movement of people united around a common cause, each taking steps in their own worlds to build a more sustainable Europe for us all.

Launched by the European Commission, the Pact is part of the European Green Deal and is helping the EU to meet its goal to be the first climate-neutral continent in the world by 2050.
